Tailor-made educational programs provide these students with basic life skills and fundamental concepts that will help them function as independently as possible on a day-to-day basis.



ANNUAL REPORT 2020-2021

On August 2020, during corona crisis, we were distributed groceries and vegetables to the physically challenged persons from our institution.



During corona lockdown period, on September 2020, we provided provisions and vegetables to the tribes locating near red hills.



On October 2020, we distributed food to the poor and road side beggars who were mostly affected during the corona lockdown.



We teach vocational training for intellectual disabled children and adult.



On January 2021, artificial limb has been donated from “Vishalayam” to auto driver to overcome his disability after amputation because of an accident.



On February 2021, “Vishalayam” set up a small scale business of selling floor cleaning liquids like phenyl, Lysol, etc for an leprosy surviving person



On March 2021, wheel chair has been provided to a polio affected person Mr. megavanan on behalf of our institution to uplift his well being.



TRAINING PROGRAMMES:

- We had set up a regular online meeting with the parents to handle the children during the lockdown period.
- We organised online classes for the parents to train the children for basic needs during the lockdown period.
